### Prayer of Spiritual Communion for Those Who Cannot Attend Mass

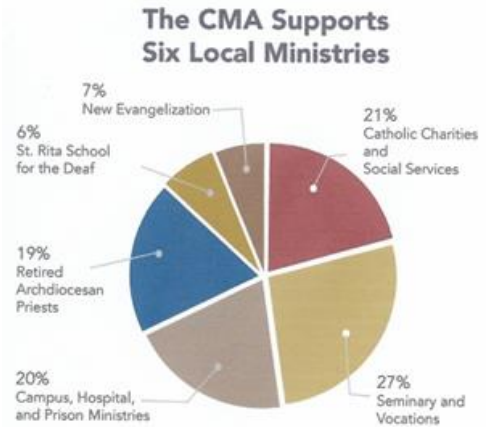

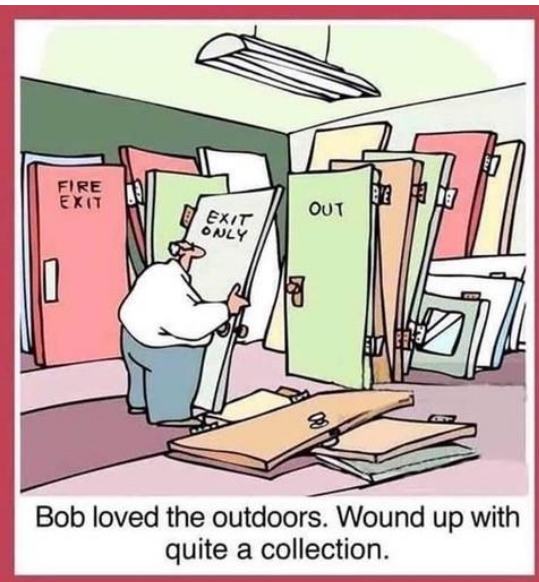


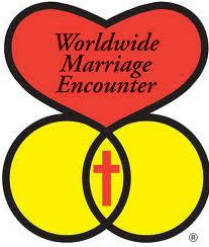
## CATHOLIC MINISTRIES APPEAL 2021
